Entrance requirements to the Foundation year

- → Baccalauréat (all series);
- → International students shall provide evidence of equivalent qualifications to the baccalauréat and advanced level in french.

Admission

A physical A4 case file to send to École Camondo, comprising:

- → the enquiry form which you can also download from our website;
- → any certificate proving you are attending your last year in secondary school or copy of the Baccalauréat or any equivalent;
- \rightarrow copies of your last 2 years of secondary school's reports;
- → a CV or resume;
- → a concise hand-written cover letter (double-sided maximum) but precise and personal;
- → representative works (duplicates or photos) showing diversity of skills but mainly keenness, sensitivity and commitment.

Calendar

Admission files must be sent by applicants, starting in January prior to the beginning of the autumn term. Applicants then get a response in the course of the month following posting. Final registration will therefore be validated according to the order of reception of the applicant's confirmations. Waivers, coupled with a penalty, are possible until the 30th of June, 2018.

Fees and rates 2018-2019

- → 8.300€ in tuition fees due on registration including 8.000€ refundable in case of failure at the Baccalauréat and unforeseen or force majeure cases and 300€ registration fees non refundable;
- \rightarrow time payment possible.

Status

The Foundation Year students enjoy full student status in France but not Crous's helps.

The Foundation Year can be part of a professional continuing training, even if part-time.

International applicants

At the start of the school year, international students deliver a copy of their residence permit after procurement of their student visa.
